### Homeless Programs: Transition Policies and Changes

*HUD webinar on Dec. 18*

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) will host a webinar titled "Homeless Programs: Transition Policies and Changes" on **Dec. 18 at 3:30 p.m. EST**. This webinar is intended for Supportive Housing Program (SHP) and Shelter Plus Care (S+C) Program grantees that are renewing grants in the FY 2012 Continuum of Care (CoC) Program Competition.

The purpose of this webinar is to explain which regulatory requirements of the CoC Program apply to renewing grants, and discuss the regulatory requirements of SHP and S+C that will continue to apply upon renewal under the CoC Program. Participants will also be able to identify what changes to their grants will constitute a significant grant amendment and the subsequent implications of the change(s).
